RPIA is awarding two college scholarships (\$1,250 each) for deserving high school seniors. Awards will be announced on June 1, 2023. Please see details below for additional information:

Award Details

RPIA seeks to recognize, encourage, and support our youth residents. Each year we offer a scholarship to two deserving high school seniors who are planning to enroll in a postsecondary institution following high school graduation. This will be a one-time award of \$1,250 to be awarded to two graduating seniors who reside within the boundaries of the Rosedale Park neighborhood and who have demonstrated effort and promise during their high school career. Although high GPA will be considered, it is not determinative. Particular value will be placed on demonstrated contributions to the community. This scholarship will be offered on an annual basis.

Application Criteria

- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in 2023
- Applicant must be a Rosedale Park resident with household dues paid

What to submit

- Proof of residence in Rosedale Park (this can be a picture ID with address or copy of mail or other record with address)
- Student essay summarizing your community service or civic contributions throughout high school (500 words or less)
- Most recent report card with cumulative GPA listed
- Documentation of acceptance to a post-secondary institution
