
City Adopts Every-Week Recycling, Bulk, Yard Waste Plan

The Detroit City Council approved a plan last week that will change the current every-other-week pickup schedule for bulk, recycling, and yard waste to a schedule that will pick up all types of waste every week. Regular weekly trash pickup will continue as-is. There will be an additional \$10 per year fee added to the waste collection fee, which is collected along with property tax payments.

The DPW conducted a number of online surveys to measure public interest in the program change, with the last round of surveys coming only two weeks ago. According to city press statements, the overwhelming majority of responses were in favor of the changes. Watch the weekly eBlast to find out when the service change will start.
